



Upcoming Building & Grounds Maintenance Work

Roof contract was signed and submitted to begin work on repairing the Mitcham House roof. The contractor has filed for the permits.

The Vestry has selected W.C. Fields to do the landscaping work around the area between the Mitcham House and the church and also to handle the masonry work on the front steps of the church and the foundation of the Mitcham House. They are our snow removal contractors as well. They are very knowledgeable about what plants will thrive in that area but recently bought out a garden center so they have some appropriate shrubbery that they will donate. They also have contact with a masonry guy who will handle that work.

Other News

We are restarting Ushers with one serving at the front door and one serving at the Moore St door. Please let the office know if you are interested in being an usher. Only requirement is a ready smile and being at church by 8:45am.
