
Thank you to the St. James' Altar Guild for arranging the beautiful Easter flowers for our Easter Sunday worship!

A Reminder about our Sale of Shop-Rite and Weis Market Cards

Each month we solicit orders for grocery gift cards. The orders are taken on the 3rd week of the month, the cards are ordered on the fourth week of the month and the cards are then delivered on the first weekend of the subsequent month. (Orders for the May cards were taken on the week after Easter and will be delivered on May 4th.).

This is a great fund raiser because St. James' gains 5% for each card purchased (ex. \$5 on a \$100 card). When you buy the card, you get the full-face value to spend and we get 5%!

The cards are sold in denominations of \$25, \$50, and \$100 for both Weis Markets and Shop-Rite. The money that we earn is divided between use for ministry (Mission Strategy) and for our general operating budget. We also routinely ask for donations of \$25 cards to be added to our holiday food bags and for the Summer BackPack program.

Mother's Day North Porch Collection

Since 1984, North Porch Centers for Women and Infants has been providing emergency aid, in the form of baby supplies, to mothers and infants in northern New Jersey, to help them stabilize and improve the quality of their lives. Clients in Hackettstown, Morristown, Dover, Jersey City, and Newark are able to visit up to six times a year and at each visit receive one week's supply of diapers, wipes, formula, baby food and toiletries. In conjunction with our recognition of mothers on Mother's Day, we will collect diapers, formula, and wipes for North Porch during the entire month of May. Donations may be brought on Sunday or dropped off in the tub on the porch of Mitcham House during the week.

St. James' Outing to Rutherfurd Hall, Allamuchy: ***Save The Date*** Saturday, June 14th, at 10 AM

If you have wondered what that building is right before Route 80 on 517 North, after the pond, here is your chance to have a tour. At one time, it was the summer "cottage" of the Rutherfurd family, who owned property in Allamuchy and Tranquility, built for Winthrop Rutherfurd, father of Lucy Rutherfurd, who was known to be linked to President Franklin D Roosevelt. You will get to see inside the beautiful historical site and hear stories of its history. It eventually was sold to Daughters of the Divine Charity and then purchased by Allamuchy Township Board of Education and is used as an elementary school for residents of Allamuchy.

Cost is \$15. Per person and a headcount will be needed by June 8th.




